

Castleisland-born Priest appointed Domestic Prelate

ON VERY Rev. Monsgr. Maurice Woulfe, Pastor, Infant of Prague Church, Buffalo, New York, His Holiness, The Pope, has conferred the further honour of appointing him a Domestic Prelate with the title of Right Rev. Monsgr.

Monsgr. Woulfe is fourth son of Mr. Maurice Woulfe, P.C., and the late Mrs. Jo Woulfe, Castleisland. He is nephew of the late Very Rev. Patrick Woulfe, P.P., author of "Slainte Gael is Gaul" and other works; of Dr. Timothy Woulfe, M.D., Gratloe and Dublin, and of Mr. John J. Woulfe, P.C., Cratloe.

Monsgr. Woulfe received his early education at Gratloe N.S., Abbeyfeale, principally from the late Mr. David Ward, N.T., Tour. Successful class mates of his are the Rev. John C. O'Connor, C.S.Sp., Rockwell, who spent many years in Africa; Very Rev. Christy Roche, a pastor in the United States; Mr. Michael Sheehy, a Vocational teacher in Dublin, and Mr. Dan Ahern, N.T., Ballybunion.

Monsgr. Woulfe was for some years Director of the Catholic Youth Movement in the Dioceses of Buffalo, and he has received several lay honours in the United States, amongst them is the Key to Niagara Falls.
