

Last Will of Richard L. Wolfe.

Know all men by these Presents, that I, Richard L. Wolfe of the town of Audubon, County of Audubon and State of Iowa, do make publish and declare this as my last will and testament, as soon as convenient after my decease, I direct that my executor herein named pay all just debts owing to me at that time.

I give devise and bequeath to my wife Mary Wolfe all of my personal property of every kind and description which I may own at the date of my decease giving to her the right to use and enjoy said property during her lifetime with the right to sell and dispose of any or all of said property if necessary for her support and the support of our daughter Irene Wolfe. After the death of my wife I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Irene Wolfe whatever remains undisposed of of my personal property.

I give devise and bequeath to my wife Mary Wolfe a life estate in all the real estate which I may own at the date of my decease which at this date comprises two farms in Cameron Township, Audubon County, Iowa and the house and lot in Audubon, Iowa where we reside and any and all other real estate which I may then own or hereafter acquire and to have and to hold the said real estate during the term of her natural life and no longer. All of the above devises and bequests to my wife are made in law and instead of her dower interest in my estate.

I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Irene Wolfe all the real estate which I may own at the date of my decease wherever the same may be situated and give to her a perfect and absolute title but subject however to my wife's life estate therein.

I hereby appoint my said wife to be the executor of my estate and direct that she shall not be required to give any bonds as such executor. Audubon Iowa May 9th 1901
